❁ Sniff water into the nose and blow it out three times.

❁ Wash the face thoroughly three times.

- ❁ *Zakat* is a sacred donation that is obligatory upon every financially capable Muslim once a year.
- ❁ Muslims distribute a portion of their wealth to the needy in order to purify their possessions.
- ❁ *Zakat* enables the poor in Muslim societies to meet their basic needs and eliminates their sense of deprivation.

Upon Whom is Zakat Obligatory?



Zakat is obligatory upon every sane and adult Muslim who possesses wealth equivalent to or exceeding 7.5 tolas of gold or 52.5 tolas of silver throughout the year.

How Much is Zakat Obligatory?

2.5%








Distributing 2.5% of one's accumulated wealth to the poor is considered *Zakat*.

In addition to *Zakat*, we should also continue to help the needy through voluntary charity (*nafl sadaqat*).

What is Sawm (Fasting)?



In Arabic, fasting is called "sawm," which means to refrain.



Refraining from food, drink, and carnal desires from the time of Fajr prayer until the time of Maghrib prayer is called "fasting."



Muslims observe 29 or 30 days of fasting during the holy month of Ramadan each year.

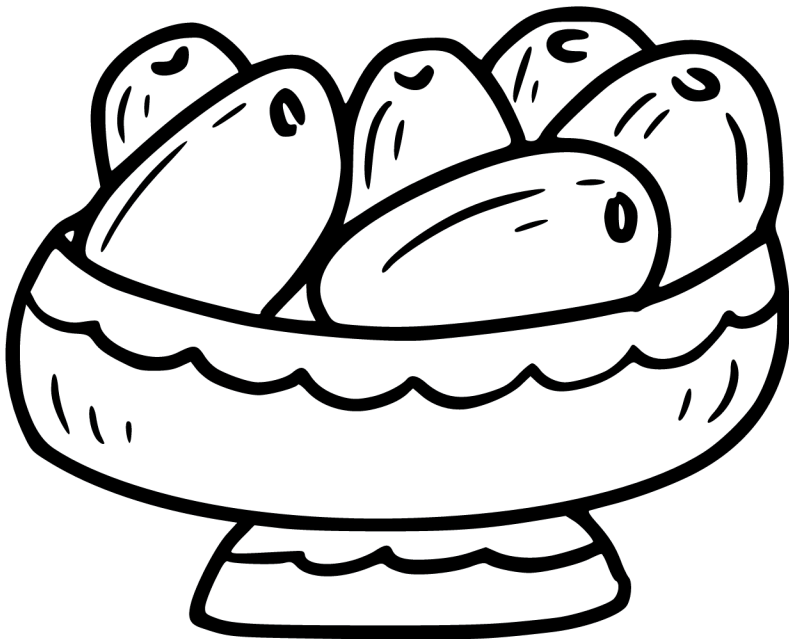

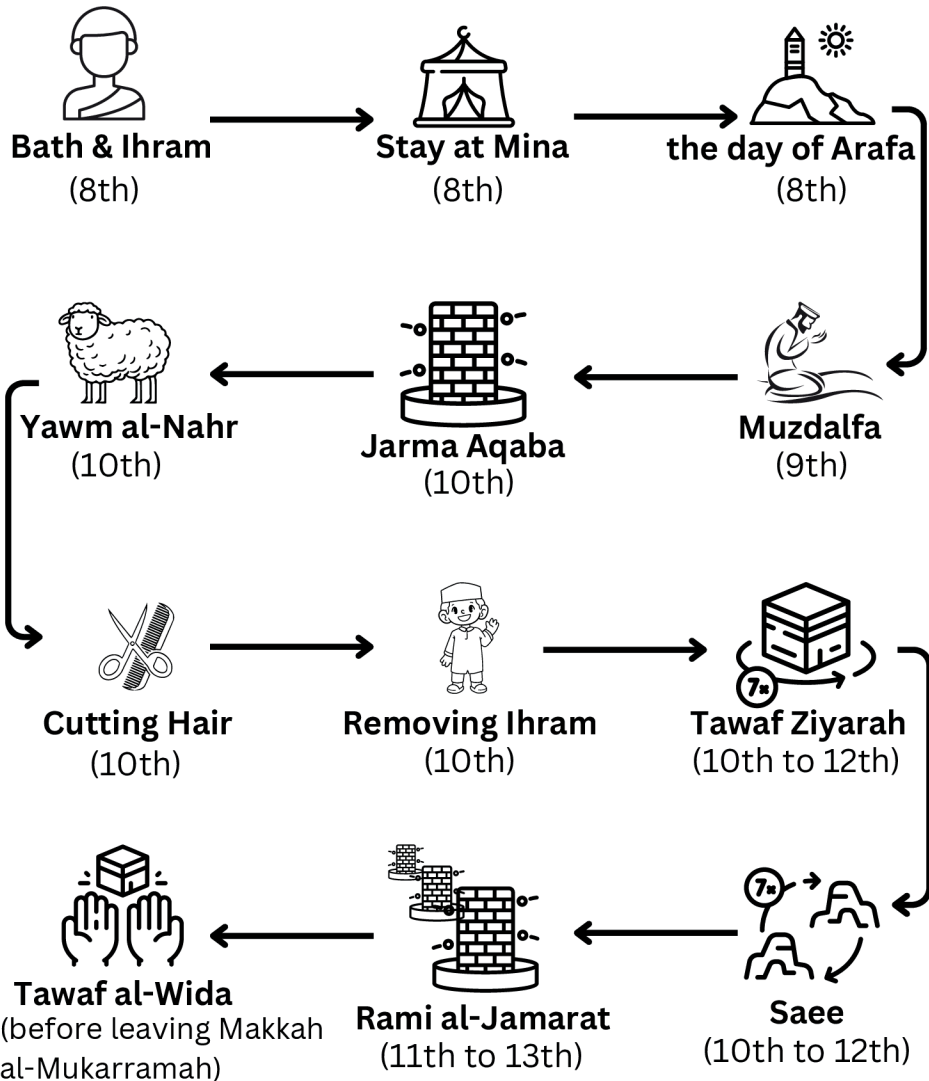

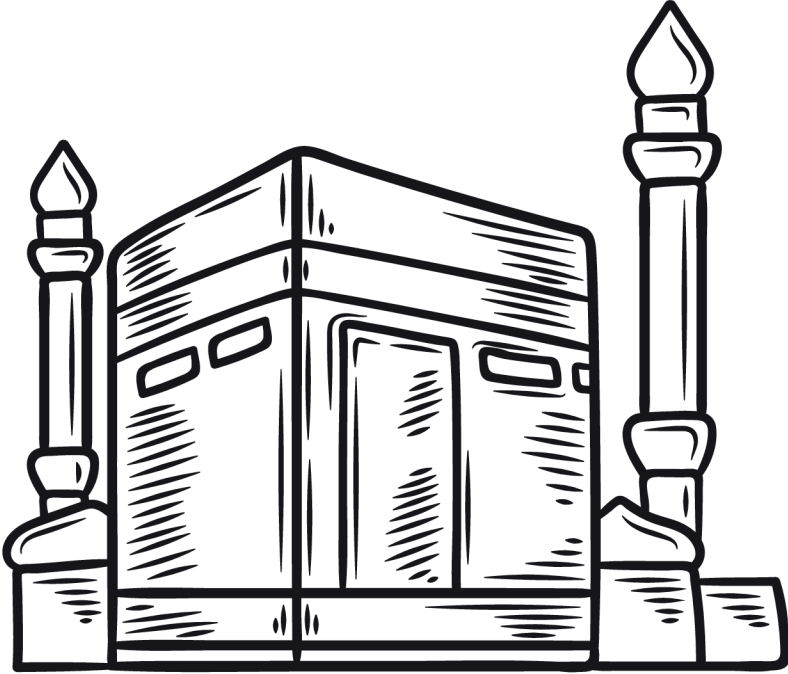
